Q. What is a Rally?

A motor home rally is a gathering of coaches that participate in interesting local sightseeing, some or all meals, happy hours, games, and a LOT of fellowship.

The types of rallies are:

1. Regional BAC rallies where 10 to 60 coaches are involved. These rallies are the core of our club and are held coast to coast. We feel these rallies are so important to the enjoyment of the club.
2. BAC Lead-In rallies involve 75 to 200 coaches. These rallies (two each year) precede a major FMCA International rally. We have factory service at these events.
3. Rolling rallies start in one place and end up hundreds or thousands of miles away! There are usually 10 to 20 coaches, typically heading to a Lead-In rally with interesting stops along the way.
4. Coming Home rallies (East & West) draw as many as 150 to 400 coaches and are not a BAC function. Factory service is available. The rally is a Monaco event where many BAC members volunteer to help.
5. FMCA rallies are comprised of all types of coaches. The two major International rallies may draw as many as 5000 coaches, often even more!
